When are students allowed in FHS?

- Students will be schedule to come in and complete tasks that cannot be completed virtually (EX: science labs, construction)
- Students will be scheduled primarily from 8:00 to 10:30 but may be asked to come in during scheduled class times.

Google Meet and Attendance

- **All students are to participate in their Google Meets every day.**
- Since we are remote to start the year, all students will participate in their A and B day classes according to the attached calendar.
- **We will only use the anchor/boat schedule when we return to onsite learning.**
- There may not be a presentation or live session each day, but this is the designated time for students to interact with their teachers for a given class.
- Teachers will take attendance every day

What are the Quarantine Rules?

- You can be quarantined if you are in “close contact” with an individual that is confirmed positive or a probable positive.
- Close contact is defined as within 6ft for 15 minutes or more.
- IDPH considers an outbreak if TWO students in a class test positive.
