

A Night in Hollywood Prom 2022 -- May 14, 2022



Ticket Sales: Prom Tickets will be sold for the time period beginning April 18th and ending April 22nd-ONE week only! Students may sign up and pay during that weekeach morning in the cafeteria or during RTI/after school in room 23 (Ms. Brzezinski's room). Ticket prices are \$30.00 per person (this includes meal, beverage, dessert, tip, etc.). This is the cost even if you choose to eat elsewhere! We ask that you try to sign up as a group. Each table seats eight. There will be no late sales after April 22nd and NO refunds after that time as we must meet a deadline with exact numbers for the venue!

After Prom- ALL juniors and seniors may attend After Prom! If you do not plan on attending Prom itself, you must sign up with Ms. Brzezinski during ticket sales anyway to determine eligibility.

Prom Regulations/Guests:

***Eligibility grades to attend Prom will be run FOUR weeks prior to the dance. If anyone is ineligible at that time, two weeks are given to improve grades. After two weeks, grades will be looked at again and if you are still ineligible, you may <u>not</u> attend Prom!

Prom is a Junior/Senior event and each junior or senior may invite the following to attend:

- 1. Someone that they are dating from FHS or another high school (under the age of 21 years but at least in high school)
- 2. If a Junior or Senior from FHS would like to invite a student from another high school or from FHS that is not a date but just a friend, that student must be either a junior or senior in high school and under the age of 21 years

Dates Who Do Not Attend FHS:

All prom attendees that are not students from FHS must fill out the required form with signatures and then have their date return it to Ms. Brzezinski no <u>la**ter than Friday, April**</u> **<u>22nd.</u>** All outside dates should have an ID available that evening!

***Prom is a FORMAL event and dress should be appropriate-If you have any questions see Ms. Brzezinski.

Grand March:

The Grand March will be held on Saturday, May 14th, 2022 in the West Gym. Students who intend to participate in this event will enter the north doors of the building between 4:50 and 5:10 p.m. The grand march will begin at 5:15 and parents and friends are invited to enter through the southwest door to view the introductions and take photographs.

Students participating in the grand march are asked to line up in the hallway behind the stage. An adult will be present to help organize students, please listen carefully to directions!

Students will fill out a form with their names, which will then be handed to the announcer as each couple comes onto the stage to be presented. Students will walk to the decorated arch on the stage and stand in front of it when introduced. Pause for a few seconds so that family and friends may take photographs. All couples should then proceed to the south wall of the gym and line up until all introductions have been made. Family and friends will then have an opportunity to take more photos of couples and larger groups. Except for chaperones, no parents or friends will be admitted to the Prom.

Meal:

Arrive at the Tuscany Room behind Rastrelli's-NOT through the regular Rastrelli's restaurant (see map) between 6:15 and 6:45 p.m. A buffet dinner will be served beginning at 7:00 p.m. You must sign in with the chaperones seated at the door of the reception area. Should you choose not to eat the buffet, you must arrive at the Tuscany Room in Clinton between 7:45 and 8:00 p.m. Do not arrive before this time as other prom attendees will be finishing their meals.

Dance:

The dance will begin at 8:00 p.m. and will last until 11:00 p.m. Students may leave beginning at 10:30 p.m. If you need to leave before 10:30 p.m., prior permission is required. As Prom is a formal event, the chaperones and sponsors request that suggestive or inappropriate dancing does not take place at this dance. We want everyone to have a good time at Prom, but if this type of dancing occurs you will be asked to stop or sit down if it continues. There will be consequences for your actions. If your date is not enrolled in Fulton High School, you will be responsible for their actions as well. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter. We want everyone attending Prom to feel comfortable on the dance floor.

Alcohol Free Prom:

*** Breathalyzer tests will be administered ***

Neither an FHS student nor the date of a student will be admitted to the Prom if he or she has been drinking alcohol. No alcohol will be sold at the Tuscany Room to an FHS student or the date of the student.

Photographs:

Professional photographs will be taken at the Tuscany Room by Persona Studios. Please have the picture envelopes filled out with the correct money or check enclosed. <u>Large groups who would like photographs should make every effort to be organized that evening with an envelope filled out and money collected prior to having the photograph taken</u>.
