We will explore:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Plant Science Basics: Understanding soil, sunshine, and water needs. Seed to Sprout: Learning how to start seeds indoors and transplant them outside. Edible Fun: Planting seasonal vegetables and herbs that they can enjoy during harvest.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Attracting Beauty: Growing colorful flowers to support pollinators like bees and butterflies.</p> <p>This is a hands-on adventure where you'll learn a valuable skill and take home your own potted plants! <p>Cooking Around the World (Mabaga)</p>	<p>4th - 12th</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Do you like eating food? Do you like cooking food? Do you like learning about and experiencing new cultures? THEN THIS IS FOR YOU!</p> <p>Students will participate in an immersive experience that allows them to learn about a new country/culture each day.</p> <p>For 3-4 days there will be a guest speaker (in person or via Google Meet) who explains about their unique culture and will help students cook a food dish from their country. <p>Babysitting 101 (Mabaga)</p>	<p>4th - 12th</p>	<p>Students will learn different methods and techniques for babysitting kids from infant-elementary age. This will be SUCH a great class for students with younger siblings/family members, for anyone who wishes to babysit in the future, or anyone who currently already babysit. I cannot stress how important the safety tips are that we are learning in this class, as well as MANY ideas for becoming a successful babysitter. Also, we are not just talking about these topics, students are getting to experience children in-person and are able to interact with each age group throughout the week.</p> <p>Each day will be focused on different topics.:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Day 1- Safety protocol (CPR, First Aid, Swim Safety, Car Safety, Sleep Safety, Choking Hazards, etc.) Guest Speaker- We will also divide up the class into groups and each group will be assigned an age group. The group will work throughout the whole week on preparing for their child that will come and visit/hang out with them on Friday.</li> <li>-Day 2- Infants and Toddler</li> <li>-Day 3- Elementary Age</li> <li>-Day 4- Visit from the Fulton Fire Department/EMTs to discuss babysitting protocol, fire safety while babysitting, CPR, First Aid, etc.</li> <li>-Day 5- Group Projects. This is when we bring in actual kids of each age group that was assigned and students have the chance to interact and prepare activities for their child. (Students will work on these projects for the entirety of the week).</li> </ul> <p>Each day there will be an actual child who comes to visit our classroom that is the age that we are focused on for that day. This allows the students to get a better idea of what they would be handling with each age group and is a great way to give examples. This is a very hands-on learning experience where students get the opportunity to learn many different skills that are necessary in order to be a successful babysitter.</p> <p>This class is NOT just for girls, we have had MANY boys take this class in the past and it is JUST as beneficial for them as it is for girls.</p>

<p>Piece by Piece: Ultimate Puzzle Lab (Mabaga)</p> 	<p>4th - 12th</p>	<p>Puzzle Masters Studio</p> <p>Love puzzles? Love building things? Then this class is the perfect fit! Self Care and Wellness: Taking Care of Your Mind and Body (Norman)	4th - 8th	<p>In this class, students will learn the importance of taking care of both their mental and physical health in fun and engaging ways. Throughout the week, students will enjoy peaceful walks, a yoga session, and learn other ways to move their bodies and calm their minds. Basketball 6th-8th (Eden)	6th - 8th	This summer, boys and girls in 6th-8th grade can join our fun and engaging basketball class! Participants will build fundamental skills like dribbling, passing, and shooting, while enjoying exciting games and activities that promote teamwork and confidence.
Blitzball (Eden)	6th - 8th	6th-8th graders may join our Summer Blitzball Enrichment Class for an action-packed program where kids will learn the fundamentals of Blitzball, sharpen their throwing, pitching, and hitting skills, and enjoy fun, fast-paced games. This class is perfect for players of all skill levels, combining teamwork, strategy, and exciting gameplay.

Pickleball (Eden)	6th - 8th	Want to learn how to play pickleball!? We will go over rules and how to play the game of Pickleball! Pickleball is a growing sport and a lot of fun to play with family and friends. Students will learn sportsmanship, rules of the game, and how to properly play.
Badminton (Eden)	6th - 8th	Students will learn the basics of badminton, including rules, scoring, and court setup, while practicing serving, rallying, and footwork. The class includes skill drills and fun games designed for all ability levels. No experience needed—just a great way to stay active, build coordination, and enjoy friendly competition this summer.
Cakes and Candles (Kampe)	6th - 8th	"Cakes and Candles" will consist of just that! We will make and decorate our own cake to take home and enjoy. We will also make our own lavender scented candle to enjoy at parent discretion.
Beads, Macramé, and Jewelry (Kampe)	4th - 8th	We will complete several activities in this class. One being beaded animal key chains, and another craft using a technique called macramé. We will also be making our own hand stamped necklace.
STEAM Activities (Maloney)	4th - 8th	Students will be doing science activities each day.
No-Bake Baking Class (Norman)	4th - 8th	In this class, students will learn kitchen safety, measuring, and how to follow recipes while making simple no-oven treats! Math, reading, and teamwork are built in as students create and taste their creations.  Rice crispy bars, fruit and yogurt parfaits, cheesecake cups, energy bites (includes peanut butter), Oreo truffles
Ceramic Painting (Hoffman)	4th - 12th	Students will learn the art of painting on ceramics. Students may choose from a variety ceramics to paint. Some of the types item that may be available to paint include various figurines such as gnomes, insects, animals, or sea creatures, a vase, a dish, or a mug and a piggy bank. Students will have the opportunity to paint each day. Students may keep their creations for themselves or give them as gifts!  Students will be allowed to paint 4-5 different items throughout the week.
Diamond Art (Loncar)	4th - 12th	Students will get the opportunity to pick out their own diamond art kit that they will complete. We will spend the week working on our diamond art while relaxing to music and spending time getting to know everyone in the room. At the end of the week, finished or not, students will get to take their diamond art home to enjoy!
Lego Club (Loncar)	4th - 12th	Who doesn't love Legos?! Students will participate in daily building challenges, sometimes working independently and other times working in a small group. At the end of each class, students will present their build and explain what they created. After everyone presents, voting will take place on whose build was the best of the day with a small prize being awarded.

Coding with Scratch (Loncar)	4th - 12th	Students will learn how to code using the online website Scratch. Students will learn basic coding skills to get an object to move but also learn how to create a game, last year we coded the beginning steps for our very own Geometry Dash!
